

Mid Size Philipps Screwdriver








This is the planned place to install the Cupholder







Select the right size for the support material – the best choice is the one that fits tight and won't be lose between the wood covering and the installation surface

Use the Screws to fix the Support material to the Cupholder as shown in the picture

This is the front part of the Cupholder

The next slide shows how to fix the rear





The installed Front Support for our Cupholder's goes all the way under the Shifterwood Cover of your R107 to fix the front on the installation surface.

As shown, the support goes all the way below the Wood Cover







The rear cup should get fixed with the third and bigger screw in your package. Once the support is pushed as far as possible in driving direction under the Shifterwood Cover you can proceed to screw in the rear cup.
